MALES:

- Black tie

FEMALES:

- Elastic hair bands - Same color as hair (Clips are allowed, but must be same color as hair. NO Scrunchies, elastic headbands, or plastic headbands.)
- Bobby pins (Must match hair color)
- Large bottle of hair gel* (Without alcohol)
- Sock bun (Same color as hair)

BOTH MALE AND FEMALES:

- Sticks of deodorant (Non-aerosol)
- Tubes of toothpaste*
- Container of foot powder (Non-aerosol)
- Toothbrushes, and (1) Plastic toothbrush holder (Non-electric toothbrush)
- Containers of dental floss
- Bars of soap (mild scent or unscented)
- Bottles of shampoo/conditioner* (NO liquid body wash, i.e. Old Spice or Axe body wash)
- Tube of ChapStick/Lip balm (NO scent, flavor, or tint)
- Bottle of unscented lotion* (Medicated lotion needs preapproval)

• Pairs of shower shoes (flip-flop footwear to wear in the shower), either black or grey

• Books of Stamps

- *As USPS is considering closing our local Pierce Post Office, and has already scheduled it for reduced hours, we have been told that only increased revenue will assist in keeping it open. Obviously, with the volume of mail generated and received at the Academy, having a local service window is crucial to our ability to communicate.
